

Protocol between Brighton & Hove Strategic Partnership and the Arts & Creative Industries Commission (Brighton & Hove)

Both partnerships agree that:

- The Arts & Creative Industries Commission will be the focal point for Cultural and arts organisations and others to work collaboratively to inform and influence strategic planning of arts and cultural activities in Brighton and Hove.
- The Arts & Creative Industries Commission will provide city wide leadership around the arts agenda. They will continue to work closely with other delivery partnerships and outcome partnerships on areas of mutual concern.
- Both parties will encourage the use of the Arts & Creative Industries Commission as the arts and culture arm of the Brighton & Hove Strategic Partnership.
- The Arts & Creative Industries Commission will seek to use their involvement with the Brighton & Hove Strategic Partnership to promote the Arts and Culture agenda amongst other members of the Brighton & Hove Strategic Partnership.
- Both Parties will seek to maximise the impact of the Arts & Creative Industries Commission on the social, economic and environmental well being of Brighton and Hove.
- Relevant information relating to and arising from Brighton & Hove Strategic Partnership activities and plans will be shared with Arts & Creative Industries Commission.
- The Arts & Creative Industries Commission will be responsible for contributing to the delivery of the Sustainable Community Strategy as part of their ongoing work.
- The Arts & Creative Industries Commission will also work with the Public Service Board, as the delivery arm of the Brighton & Hove Strategic Partnership, to help deliver the relevant sections of the City Performance Plan (CPP).
- The Arts & Creative Industries Commission agrees to provide reports on performance and activity, where required, relating to progress against Sustainable Community Strategy priorities and will contribute to the overall performance management framework for the Brighton & Hove Strategic Partnership.
- Members of the Arts & Creative Industries Commission will have a representative on the Brighton & Hove Strategic Partnership and will enable

the use of the Arts & Creative Industries Commission to implement priorities and matters in relation to Arts and Culture on behalf of the Brighton & Hove Strategic Partnership.

- The Arts & Creative Industries Commission members agree to provide reports on allocation of resources that relate to the achievement of the partnerships shared priorities.
- The Arts & Creative Industries Commission agrees to work cooperatively with the Overview and Scrutiny function of the local authority where relevant to their work.
