1. Public Service Board Restructure – the new City Management Board

At the last PSB meeting on 16th April, the members agreed to adjust the terms of reference of the group in order to form the new City Management Board (see Appendix 1 – CMB Terms of Reference). Along with these changes, it was also agreed that the Chief Executive of Brighton & Sussex University Hospitals (BSUH) would be invited to attend this board in future.

2. Asset management across Brighton & Hove

It was agreed that the City Property Group (now the Public Sector Property Group) would be re-enlivened and given a mandate by the new CMB, along with a refresh of the membership, to take forward citywide estate issues. This group would then report back to future City Management Board meetings.

3. Single Vulnerable People: Whole Place Community Budgets

The CMB agreed that the board would coordinate the actions of public sector agencies to support the delivery of the Big Lottery Fund bid appropriately.
